

ACCOUNTING & FINANCE DEPARTMENT FALL 2016 REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR BUS1 121A

To register for BUS1 121A in Fall 2016, you must complete an online learning system called ALEKS. ALEKS will be provided at no cost if your current concentration is Accounting (ACC), AIS, or Corporate Accounting and Finance (CAF). All other students wanting to take ALEKS and enroll in BUS1 121A will need to pay the \$30 fee upon registration for ALEKS.

What is ALEKS? It is an online, self-paced learning system reviewing 55 topics from financial accounting essential for your success in Bus1 121A. It takes between 15 and 30 hours for most students to master, and can be completed in multiple sessions.

How do I sign up for ALEKS?

Complete the following accounting department survey by **June 28, 2016**:

- ALEKS will be available from **July 1** to **July 31** for all students.
- **For ACC, AIS and CAF students:** an email will be sent out **June 30** to everyone who completed the accounting department survey. The email will include 1) registration information on ALEKS and 2) a survey link on section selection of 121A.
- Add codes will be issued starting **July 11** to those who 1) finished ALEKS and 2) submitted the section selection survey
- Priority will be given to ACC, AIS and CAF students until **July 17**.
- **For all other students (Non ACC, AIS, CAF):** an email will be sent out **June 30**, to everyone who completed the accounting department survey on registration information of ALEKS. A second email will be sent out **July 18** with survey link on section selection of 121A.

The department add period ends on August 1. If you do not finish ALEKS or the section selection survey by August 1, you will have to wait for instructor adds when the Fall 2016 semester begins.
