



As a music lecturer that is only on campus 1 day/week, this kind of program is great for allowing some students outside of my courses to meet with me to talk about very relevant topics.

Consider removing the words "your" and "my" from the survey questions, they sound a bit patronizing and assumes that students solely invite professors who instruct courses that they are currently enrolled in. In my case I was invited by a female student of color seeking mentorship from a female professor of Great program...Promote it more!

I am so supportive of this program. These days it seems there are fewer opportunities for students and professors to spend quality time together compared to 30 years ago, yet the need is clearly much greater. It's such a simple idea but it works. All my friends in the business world to whom I have spoken of this program are impressed. Thank you for this small human touch.

I believe my students already are comfortable enough to come see me during my office and I am sure I would have been able to assist the student in the same manner but obviously it was nice to get a coffee with a student but not a practical approach to reach out to a large number of students

I did not know the program existed until the student contacted me, so I felt at a disadvantage from the start. This was a marginal student, so the coffee session was less than satisfying for me.

I felt like I was taking money from a student or someone who could use the resources more than I so I turned down the coffee offer.

I had two students participate in this program and this is my second time completing this survey, so I think I covered everything in the first survey -- but if you need more details just let me know!

I really appreciated this program. I enjoyed the two meetings I had. One student did not get the coffee card ahead of time and was prepared to pay out of pocket. I bought coffee instead (the obvious solution!). I didn't mind but did want to give feedback about the ease of process for students. Just the act of getting the card might be a barrier for some.

I think this program needs to have more awareness for students to take advantage of, instead of just a few posters in a few buildings. More students should take advantage of this program, I just don't think

I was approached by two students, but I had only one coffee session with one of them. Scheduling may become an issue. Also, the student who used this program is a very motivated student who was doing great in my class. So, I wonder if students who are worried about their academic progress might be shy

I would encourage more lower division students to participate. I think it could have the greatest impact

I would hope that such an initiative will continue since there is a large potential to improve student engagement that will also relate to student success. Working in a collaborative effort with other initiatives from various institutional units would be another option to consider to emphasize student engagement. As an example, a combination of interests from mentoring/advising and involvement in RSCA-related activities would be something to perhaps envisage to discuss with members from the Center for Faculty Development and the Office of Research. There is a potential to develop more student engagement beneficial to students and faculty to collaborate on RSCA-related activities.

I would like to know if other professors are announcing this program in their classrooms. It would be wonderful to survey students who took part in this program and provide some data on their experience (e.g., was it beneficial for them? did they get more out of it than a traditional office visit?)

I would like to see the program continue.

If you have the money to support this... continue it... I think that reaching out... in both directions... makes all feel just a tad more connected here @JSU!
