MA/MFA Advisory Committee Requirements

- 1. The Committee Chair of the Advisory Committee must be a full-time Tenure/Tenure-track faculty member of the Department of Art and Art History within the Program of Concentration in which the student's degree will be conferred.
- 2. At least half of the student's Advisory Committee must be faculty members of the Department of Art and Art History. Additional Advisory Committee member(s) must be faculty at SJSU (including faculty from other departments) or from an equivalent institution. Exceptions to this requirement must be approved by the Art Graduate Committee.
- 3. An optional 4th Committee Member may serve on the committee. This position may be filled by a non-academic professional in the art field (subject to approval of the Art Graduate Committee).
- 4. Graduate students (including Graduate Teaching Assistants) may not serve on the Advisory Committee.
- 5. Changes to the Advisory Committee may be made either by the student or by the Committee Members. Notify the department office immediately of any changes to the Advisory Committee and to complete the appropriate forms.
- 6. The student listed above is responsible for setting up a MINIMUM of six (6) meetings with the ART 298A or ART 298B Supervising Instructor during the semester and completing the project described on the first page of this form. Failure to meet with the Supervising Instructor and/or completing the project can result in a failing grade. Incomplete grades must comply with SJSU's policy.
- 7. When possible, arrange to meet with the Advisory Committee as a group. This is especially important for the final meeting during the graduating semester for the "Thesis Orals." The Thesis Orals is the committee critique for the thesis exhibition/project. ART 298B is the exhibition installation during the Thesis Exhibition Weeks.
