- Half of exchange students have returned home, F-1 status students are exempt from having only in-person classes, all advisors have been booked with appointments each day
 - OPT and Stem OPT employment is still undetermined because those government agencies are still not giving enough information
 - It is not guaranteed that students who go home now can return to SJSU in the fall
 - Credit/No-Credit: Students with an F-1 status must earn credit for F-1
 - Students who went home before applying for OPT are no longer eligible for it. Employment is supposed to be continuous in order to keep OPT which may be an issue.

- SJSU will receive \$31 million from the CARES act
 - The CSU system received \$550 million split between 23 campuses
 - Half of the funds will go directly to students
 - Pell Grant students & Full-time students first
 - The other half of the \$31 million will go to the institution
- SJSU Cares has seen an increase in rates
- Spring 2020 Graduation Ceremony has been combined with Fall 2020 or Spring 2021. The reasoning was because we can not predict how the pandemic would be by the end of Summer and did not want to promise students to cancel again.

B. Patrick Day (Vice President of Student Affairs)

- Setting up a meeting to discuss how the \$31 million will be used for students and the institution
- Most international students did not leave and many are staying in campus housing
- Most students who are asking for financial assistance are going to the Bill Wilson Center for support

C. Charlie Faas (Campus CFO)

- Will be discussing the student employee layoffs from Chartwells and what more we can do for students.

D. Vincent Del Casino (Campus Provost)

- Director Nguyen and I are working with the Media Relations Team to host a A.S. Update video with Provost Del Casino

- The video will be talking about the top questions students have about Credit/No Credit

VI. Important Updates

- The Governor temporarily suspended limited portions of EO 1037
 - Effective immediately, student course withdrawals earned during the spring 2020 semester or quarter shall not count against the maxima described in EO 1037
 - Students may subsequently repeat a course with a CR grade earned in spring 2020 for a letter grade
 - Units earned for a repeated course in spring 2020 shall be excluded from the 16-semester unit maximum for grade forgiveness
 - Campuses may allow students to repeat a course taken in spring 2020 even if the student has already attempted the course twice (B.2.b.)
- The limited suspension is sought to facilitate student progress toward degree completion.
- Hired Victoria Sexton as a case manager for SJSU Cares
- \$400k of basic needs funding awarded has been disbursed from the Chancellor's Office (CO) after some delays.
 - Work has started on implementing some of the program updates associated with the program proposal.
 - Rapid Rehousing funding has been delayed from the CO as we work as a system to put in place MOUs and Service Level Agreements with our off campus partners, the Bill Wilson Center. Work is continuously being done to move this project forward.
- SJSU Cares had 99 Request for Assistance forms submitted this quarter.
 - March 2020 had **38 cases** compared to **21 submissions in March 2019**. The majority of the recent cases have been students affected by COVID-19 from a fiscal perspective.
- Types of Assistance Requested (submission form asks students to designate what type of assistance they felt they needed):
 - 68.7% selected 'Housing/Homeless Resources'
 - 45.5% selected 'Financial Counseling/Resources'
 - 27.3% selected 'Food Resources'
 - 23.2% selected 'Employment Assistance'
 - 12.1% selected 'Medical/Mental Health Assistance'
 - 12.1% selected 'Other Assistance'
- On March 25th the pantry marked its one year anniversary of service to students experiencing food insecurity.
 - Spartan Food Pantry had over 24,273 visits by 4,896 unique students.
 - 64% of visits have included fresh produce (70,495 lbs in total).
