Finally, we did a first reading of the SJSU Student Demands During the COVID-19 Pandemic resolution which included different avenues for the University to take in terms of flexibility with grading (Credit/No Credit), withdrawals (W, WU, and retroactive), as well as extending add/drop dates for classes. The committee provided their feedback for the resolution and were informed regarding the importance of this resolution.

I. A.S. Committee Meetings

- Lobby Corps, November 18th
 - The committee was informed about COVID regulations stated in the CSSA policy documents.
 - Resolutions in regards to condemning aggression against Armenia and Artsakh and drafting a resolution regarding the SARS Issue in Nigeria were presented and discussed. The chair is mentioned working with the Nigerian Student Association on the SARS resolution.

II. University Committee Meetings

• Senate Executive Committee Meeting- November 16th

From the Vice President of Administration and Finance (VPAF):

VP Faas gave an update on the Campus Master Plan Committee as aligned with the strategic plan. They are conducting stakeholder interviews across campus and looking at how to develop the campus while working towards our Transformation 2030 goals. This will be a yearlong process. When the pandemic ends we may find we do not need as much space as we have, if we continue with hybrid courses.

Question: Are we moving back to the red tier level tomorrow and if so what does that mean for the campus?

Answer: We will not be all out closing like we did in March. We are much better positioned now. Also, the state guidelines gave higher education more flexibility than other businesses. Closing the campus and cancelling classes adds pressure to students in different areas like financial aid. We are adhering to the safety protocols we have in place.

From the President of Student Affairs (VPSA):

Our enrollment looks good for spring. We are up 21% in applications, but we are down 9% in graduate students. Our intent to enroll numbers are at about 84%, our graduate numbers are also up. However, what is of concern is the number of drops from fall to spring.

From the Chief Diversity Officer:

We are thrilled to announce that Dr. Patience Bryant will be joining the CDO's Office as the Director of Black/African American Equity. Dr. Patience Bryant will start December 7th, 2021.

From the Provost:

Dean of the Library and the Vice Provost for Institutional Effectiveness searches. We should hear where the CSU is at in the next 24 to 48 hours regarding AB 1460. Other issues being discussed at the CSU level include the C/NC option. Data gathered at our campus was pulled from last spring. Ten percent of all grades were changed to C/NC. However, 72% of the grades that were changed were A's, B's, or C's. Once they were changed to C/NC they added nothing to the grade point average. Also, 35% of the 72% were A's and B's, overall only 28% were D's and F's. Some D's may even have counted for passing a course. Our high achieving students were concerned that they could be hurt and opted for the C/NC option, but the Provost is not sure we helped them. The Provost does not think we should opt for C/NC for students. Provost suggested looking into our policies regarding retaking courses and changing policies regarding withdrawals.

• Academic Senate Meeting, November 23rd

Task Force on Community Safety and Policing

Patrick Day (co-chair) Edith Kinney (co-chair), Garrick Percival, and Gil Zamora introduced this conversation as a meeting that is one of a multitude of engagement meetings with the campus and some off- campus (e.g., governance organizations). This was an opportunity to share thoughts, and concerns with safety and policing and interplay between these two. Scope is to look at dynamics of UPD and thinking of equity practices of UPD, but also thinking about safety and how people feel safe or not safe. Last meeting the taskforce focused on physical plant and safety, as well as UPD and making recommendations to keep all members of our community safe and treated appropriately. Some key topics included: communication (campus communication, infrastructure), different definitions of safety, relationship between San José Police department and our UPD, challenge of accessing information around policing, UPD staffing levels, UPD time use (as part of an urban university), impact of being part of urban environment, mental health and first responding, and what kind of new innovations can we bring to safety and policing.

Discussion of Credit/No Credit and Withdrawals

Director Kaur and President Delgaillo's Response: In order to create an inclusive learning environment which encourages our students to expand their intellectual and creative horizons we need respond to the impacts of the COVID-19 Pandemic on our students' lives and instruction by making thoughtful and considered modifications to University Policies concerning grading options which is where C/NC plays a vital apart. C/NC creates equity and flexibility during a pandemic where social and economic divides have come into harsher focus. Some students have had to deal with the loss of family members, troubleshooting of a virtual learning environment,

being physically and socially isolated from the world, civil unrest due to police brutality, threats to our international student population, wildfires throughout California, and a presidential election where every person had something at stake. This topic was brought to after seeing and hearing, the immense stress students have experienced this semester.

Response from Administration:

There may be significant problems for continued probation and disqualification suspension. Concerns taking it to the committee without suspension of EO 1037. Students making decisions without fully understanding the implications, FAQ last time it took a significant time to create. Continued concern about the timeline, if we should think about further than Spring 2021. Economic hardships are likely to be happening for 2-3 years. We need to think about longer term changes in CR/NC not just tying it to COVID, but need to have a more substantive plan of support for students.

• SUBOD Personnel Committee Meeting, November 17th

The committee discussed the SUI Student Success Update, the Education Benefit Application Process (selection for December) and the process for the executive director evaluation process that will take place.

• ISA, November 16th

- The *Waitlist Policy* was considered by the senate with mostly positive feedback and suggestions. Discussion ensued about senate feedback.
- ISA committee members voted in favor of removing the upper-division and lower-division unit requirements so that 16 units can be allocated across upperand lower-division courses as needed and NOT separated as 9 units upper and 9 units lower.

• ISA, November 23rd

Referral for Credit/No Credit for Fall 2020 from Students

Challenges with choosing CR/NC now

- Last day of instruction is when the rosters are formalized. Logistical difficulties to attempt to change policy at this point in the semester.
- Would need to suspend policies of departments which will/will not accept credit/no credit for their programs.

- Member Yao warned not to repeat what we did in spring. From her perspective students did not seem to understand the ramifications of what this did to their GPA. I look forward to doing it for Spring 2021. Could extend disqualification.
- Member Leisenring shared a letter that the Chancellor's office said that Cr/No policy was possible to extend but we need to think about the ramifications for financial aid, scholarships, veterans and student athletes.
- o Timeline for the proposed policy is nearly impossible at this point. Administration is for liberal W policy but not Cr/NC. Liberal withdrawal policy would be a sense of a senate. Wording on Transcript—probably needs to be a policy.
- o Decision on DQs Suspend DQ through Fall 2020 : Majority Yes
- Decision to pursue Credit/No Credit : Majority No (President Delgadillo's vote was in favor of C/NC)

Commencement will be online for Fall 202. Spring graduation is still tentative with the hope that a vaccine is available. Decision for Spring 2021 would roughly come out in March 2021.

• Meeting with President Papazian and Vice President Day, December 2nd

Housing Protocol: students living in the residence halls will be given the opportunity to have testing on campus upon their arrival (students also have the option of doing Covid-19 testing on their own, ahead of time).

Spring Break: Recently San Diego State announced that their senate voted to alter their Spring break. Essentially this decision was to be made to further prevent Covid-19 outbreaks. President Papazian and Vice President Day mentioned how fairly new this topic is to our campus and I presented insights on how cancelling Spring Break would negatively affect students in which President Papazian and Vice President Day agreed. Though we will touch base about this topic in depth coming back from break when more information is available.
