The county decided not to move forward with SJSU being a vaccination site because while the county was interested they weren't able to commit to logistics (staffing, etc). The university was aiming for having a vaccination site on campus.

ISA F20-2 Referral Considerations

1. Unintended consequences: Changing from a letter grade to CR/NC grading basis can lead to unintended consequences, such as delaying progress to degree (when an NC is earned, instead of a D grade), having to pay back veterans benefits funds (when a NC is earned), or not qualifying for Dean's or President's Scholar honors (requires 12 graded units). Students would benefit from advising support to make informed decisions if given the option to change to CR/NC grading basis.
2. Resource constraints: Additional advising support for CR/NC petitions would create additional workload for faculty and staff advisors, taking time away from other student advising duties. Processing CR/NC petitions creates additional workload for Registrar's Office staff, which may delay processing of transcripts and diplomas.
3. Equity issues: Some undergraduate and graduate programs may not allow CR/NC grading basis due to accreditation requirements. Students using veterans benefits cannot opt for CR/NC (without having to pay back benefits funds). Students using Financial Aid should be aware that NC grades count as "attempted units" toward the eligibility limit of 180 units total.
4. Academic curriculum modification: Allowing students to change the grading basis for any course is a significant departure from normal university policy, and represents a significant modification to the curriculum. The university provides a number of resources to support students' basic needs, and mental health and wellness. These kinds of support are more appropriate remedies for the stress and anxiety that many students continue to experience as a result of the ongoing pandemic. It is important to maintain consistency in the university curriculum and academic standards during this time, rather than continue to make temporary modifications. The current policy ([F20-2](#)) does provide relief for students earning F or WU grades by changing these automatically to NC, to mitigate their impact on GPA.

Policy options to consider:

- 1. Allow students to petition to change grading basis to ABC-/NC for undergraduate courses, or AB-/NC for graduate courses.**
2. Extend the deadline for students to change grading basis to CR/NC under the normal policy F18-5 (juniors and seniors, limited to 12 units that are NOT GE courses, or courses used for a major or minor program).
