- The Finance Committee unanimously voted down a funding request for a Recognized Student Organization. Their request was for the amount of \$2,700. The organization describes that in order to work on the project for which they were asking for funds they had to meet in person which violates the protocols that Student Involvement has set forth for all RSO's. Additionally, the project the organization is working on has ties to a course requirement which is not what RSO funding is intended to fund. RSO funding is for extracurricular activities that happen via student organizations.

## **I. A.S. Committee Meetings**

- Lobby Corps Committee Meeting- March 3rd
  - The committee discussed adding SWANA to Cal State Apply and the resolution Addressing Anti-Blackness and Systemic Racism at SJSU where focused on a timeline and revision for the resolution
  - Some members also participated in a CHES Debriefing and perspective on their experience.

## **II. University Committee Meetings**

- **Senate Executive Committee Meeting- March 8th**
- President Papzian's Update:
  - University is launching a Master's Facility planning process. It will be a year-long process. It involves looking at both academic and non-academic areas and our goals over the next decade. This process is co-chaired by VP Faas and Provost Del Casino.
  - There will be a Townhall on Wednesday 03/10 on the repopulation plan. This is a day-to-day process. Every day we wake up and there are new guidelines. We expect another update no later than April 1, 2021, but probably some guidance before that. We have been working hard with VP Day's Office, Traci Ferdolage, the Provost, University Personnel, on everything that must go into this.
  - Regarding commencement, it is currently tough for universities to consider a drive through like some other campuses, such as CSU East Bay, due to our downtown location and our city streets that lead to interstates. We can't block access to interstates on public streets. It is really hard to compare one institution to another. An in person ceremony probably won't be feasible for May 2021, but students really want to celebrate with their families. We will probably do a virtual event in May, and then hopefully have them come back for an in person event in September. What we are looking at is a calendar over the course of this full year. We hope to do something in August 2021 for last year's graduating class, then in September 2021 for this year's graduating class. By December 2021, we hope to pickup with Fall as normal. A detailed Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) and Calendar for the New Year will be put together.

- Planning stages of a Racial, Equity, and Justice Symposium. This will be led by Jahmal Williams and working with VP Day, Patience Bryant, Provost Del Casino, and Lisa Millora. We hope to create an annual space to address these kinds of issues. This is in the early stages right now, but doing some really good work.
- Also launched the Campus Council on Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (CCDEI). CDO Wong(Lau) is one of the co-chairs.

#### Vice President for Administration and Finance (VPAF)

- The VPAF and his team are working on plans for reopening the campus and what must be done between now and Fall 2021. The focus is on reopening for Fall 2021. Not trying to repopulate until then. In the meantime, the University Police Department (UPD) is working on trying to keep the buildings secure with the increase in burglaries. The increase in burglaries is because there are no faculty and staff on campus right now, so there are no eyes on all the buildings. Doors have been manipulated and opened and have been caught on camera so adjustments have been made.

#### **ISA Committee Meeting March 8th**

C/NC committee reviewed all in depth considerations for C/NC some that included: Unintended consequences, Resource constraints, Equity issues, Academic curriculum modification: we presented three policy recommendation for ISA to consider

Policy options to consider:

1. Allow students to petition to change grading basis to ABC-/NC for undergraduate courses, or AB-/NC for graduate courses.
2. Extend the deadline for students to change grading basis to CR/NC under the normal policy F18-5 (in which juniors and seniors, limited to 12 units that are NOT GE courses, or courses used for a major or minor program).
3. No additional changes for Spring 2021. Per F20-2, all F grades and WU grades will be automatically changed to NC. Students have the option to petition to drop other courses (COVID-19 reasons given special consideration).

\* ISA then took a vote on these three options

VOTE: ISA would take no further action regarding the CR/NC referral for spring 2021, and will respond to the referral via memo to the Senate office.

Grade forgiveness summary:

1. Remove limits provided in current policy
2. Member comments, Amy: Graduate repeat: leave the grades on the record without grade averaging
3. Member comments, Marian: Reminded Laura about the referral regarding the change to allow repeaters to register during the start of the advance registration period. Melinda supported this change as it would benefit students making progress to degree
4. Multiple repeats-suggestion to limit the number of repeats. Melinda's recommendation-take case by case situation
5. Member comments, Marian suggested to separate the undergraduate section from graduate-clarify 7 yr and 10 yr limits impact to repeats/standards. Soma supported this suggestion and to give departments to use their discretion considering differences among disciplines. Nadia gave examples of repeat limits for some courses like Capstone, gatepost for entry courses, and see why there is a large number of students repeating a class.
