- ***Senate Executive Committee Meeting - April 26th***
 - The committee discussed faculty nominees for the Accreditation Review Committee (ARC) and the Institutional Review Board (IRB).
 - A nominee cannot serve more than two terms on the IRB according to policy. The committee debated whether the Executive Committee should consider suspending the policy to allow for the appointment.
 - Presentation on the Campus Data Warehouse (CDW).
 - The CDW provides student-level data to appropriate stakeholders in a secure and user-friendly environment. The CDW will standardize data reporting through a centralized data system. Right now there are multiple data systems on campus and some of these systems are not well coordinated.
 - **Goals and Objectives:** Build a comprehensive Campus Data Warehouse. Provide an integrated and consolidated data repository that catalogs and validates all data elements.

- ***Senate Executive Committee Meeting - May 3rd***
 - Review of CSU, Academic Council on International Program Applications
 - Memo indicated information of vacancy so that an appointment can be made according to the Academic Senate's procedures on your campus. Tenure-track or tenured faculty and academic administrators who are concerned and knowledgeable about international education efforts are eligible. The required term of appointment is three academic years. An incumbent member may be reappointed for a second and final term.
