- Lobby Corps Committee Meeting, April 21, 2021
  - The Lobby Corps committee went through the revision of the Anti-Asian American Hate Crimes Resolution and voted to bring the resolution to the AS Board of Directors
  - The committee also discussed future goals and priorities for the upcoming academic year
- AS Personnel Committee, April 22, 2021
  - During the AS Personnel Committee I presented my findings for the ED 360 review outcome report in which there are still some areas of revision for the committee to formally vote on the outcome report
  - The ED 360 report will come forward to the AS Board on 05/12 (last board meeting)

## **II. University Committee Meetings**

- Academic Senate Meeting, April 19, 2021
  - Instruction and Student Affairs Committee (I&SA): AS 1814, Policy Recommendation, Amendment A to University Policy F20-1, Adding Classes After Advance Registration (Final Reading)
  - AS 1815, Policy Recommendation, Amendment A to University Policy F20-2, Grading Changes to Support Maximum Flexibility for SJSU Students During the Prolonged COVID-19 Pandemic (Final Reading)
    - Both of these policies were passed
  - Professional Standards Committee (PS): AS 1813, Sense of the Senate Resolution, Endorsement of The University of Chicago Statement on Freedom of Expression (Final Reading)
    - Discussion on Academic Freedom and what that entails for our future as an academic institution. This University of Chicago Statement has been endorsed by approximately a hundred universities so far.
      - This has also sparked conversation due to the legislature in Idaho threatening to cut the budget of Boise State University to force it to

stop "social justice programming" and stop teaching "critical race theory."

- Budget Advisory Committee, April 22th, 2021
  - Housing Update : 2,000 students have applied for housing for the 2021-2022 academic year. No increased fees. Housing will continue to hold quarantine and isolation spaces for students. There will also not be a first year requirement for the next academic year.
  - Student eligibility/expiration for HEERF #3
    - It is still unclear when the third wave of distribution will happen and if that allocated funds will go to current grading seniors or incoming freshman/transfer students.
    - The current thinking is a June 2021 disbursement from the federal government. If before June, the current seniors could be eligible for some dollars as well. The Finance team is looking into the rules for disbursement and the timing. The team will also investigate the clear definition of a “graduated student.” Dollars must be given to currently enrolled students.
    - Here is the guidance on CARES (HEERF1), CHSAA (HEERF 2) on student aid. HEERF 3 is not published yet.

    - Language is also still unclear of what defines a student no longer a student? (For eligible purposes)
      - Does it mean the last day of instruction? Graduating? When their diplomas come?
- CFO Update:
  - Recently, the SJSU President, UP and Unions and Finance representatives met to discuss the re- population. Every one of the unions voiced the concern over vaccinations prior to re-population. There was 100% concurrence from the unions on the need for students to be vaccinated prior to coming back to campus in fall 2021. The CSU also knows the current vaccinations are approved under emergency use authorization, thus mandating a requirement.
  - Next steps – the finance team will reassess status and our future financial landscape. Had the opportunity to be able to talk to the City of San Jose, City Manager who happened to be on campus. The topic: parking. We expect more demand. Attempting to get access to the 4 th Street (Flames) garage. He is willing to have a conversation on the topic. FYI – the VTA Rapid 500 comes from Berryessa Bart to our campus.

- SJSU Alquist building is still on pace to open 5 years from now. A staff person will be dedicated to bringing this building online. They will work with Tracy from FD&O.
