

BIKES ON TRANSIT

VTA All VTA buses are equipped with exterior bike racks that accommodate up to two bicycles. When the racks are filled, two bicycles are allowed inside the bus, subject to the driver's discretion.

All light rail vehicles are also equipped with interior bike racks, accommodating up to four bicycles.

HWY 17 EXPRESS These buses are equipped with front-mounted racks with space for three standard-size bicycles.

CALTRAIN Each bike car can carry a maximum of 24-40 bicycles. The bike car is located in the middle and northernmost end of the train.

BART During non-commute hours, bikes are allowed on all trains except for the first car. During commute hours, bikes are not allowed in the first 3 hours. Folded bikes are allowed in all cars at all times.

ACE Each bike car has 14 bike stalls with 2 additional stalls on the lower level. Look for the BIKE CAR sign affixed to door locations of the car.

BIKESHARE A short-term bicycle rental service with discounted student memberships. Drop off at any kiosk in the service area. Learn more at ts.sjsu.edu on the Exclusive Student Offers page.

BIKING ON THE ROAD

ALWAYS WEAR A HELMET.

2

PEDESTRIANS HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY. BIKES AND CARS ALWAYS YIELD TO PEDESTRIANS.

STOP BEHIND THE CROSSWALK. LEAVE CROSSWALKS CLEAR FOR PEDESTRIANS. ALWAYS STOP BEHIND THE LINE.

4

MIND THE SIGNS AND LIGHTS. STOP AT STOP SIGNS. OBEY RED LIGHTS.

GO WITH THE FLOW. RIDE IN THE SAME DIRECTION AS TRAFFIC. WALK YOUR BIKE ON THE SIDEWALK IF YOU'RE ON THE WRONG SIDE OF A ONE-WAY STREET.

6

TAKE THE LANE. WHEN RIDING NEXT TO PARKED CARS OR IN A NARROW LANE - IF YOU FEEL SAFER, TAKE THE LANE AND RIDE OUTSIDE THE DOOR ZONE.

ENCLOSURE ACCESS

- Visit ts.sjsu.edu and search for bicycle enclosures on the **Bike to SJSU** page.
- Follow the listed instructions on how to turn in your agreement form. Be sure to complete the form in full.
- Present SJSU Tower ID (required) and pay the bike enclosure key fee.

USING THE ENCLOSURES

- Hold access key sensor near the sensor to open the enclosure door. Do not allow anyone to enter with you.
- Close the door promptly when you enter or exit. Report all suspicious activity to University Police (408)924-2222.
- Use a U-Lock to lock your bicycle's frame and wheel to the bike rack.
- Do not repair your bicycle in the enclosure.
- Unattended bicycles will be removed by UPD. A notice will be sent to owners of unattended bicycles 48 hours before removal.
- Do not leave unused bicycle locks in the enclosure. Locks that are not being used to secure a bicycle will be removed.
- Do not place advertisements, fliers or posters, on lockers, walls or any other Associated Students or SJSU property.
- A.S. is not responsible for theft, damage or misplacement of property.
- Bicycle enclosures are not for overnight or long-term uses.
