

SJSU Children's Hearing Screening Program: Preschool – First Grade

The goal of the SJSU Voluntary Hearing Screening Program is to provide a needed service to the community. Early identification of hearing loss is an important factor in a child's development of speech and language.

San José State University students, from the Connie L. Lurie College of Education, supervised by a licensed, certified Audiologist, are taught the specific skills to evaluate children's hearing. Our students will come to your facility and test the children in the environment in which the children already feel comfortable. SJSU students are trained to ensure that the results are valid indicators of the child's hearing and not simply due to the child trying to please the evaluator.
