- Students who have previously received this scholarship are ineligible.
- The scholarship is available to all students described above regardless of age, gender, ethnicity, religion or sexual orientation.

The selection of the recipient shall be by a review committee of no less than 3 persons, selected by the Interim Dean & Interim Associate Dean of the College of Business.
