Executive-Style MBA: A part-time, flexible evening program that was developed to work around the constraints of a working professional's full schedule. Classes are held evenings and Saturdays in accelerated eight-week cycles with some classes online. Classes meet at Techmart in Santa Clara, the meeting hub for professionals just like you. On the whole, our student body is a multicultural assembly. The learning environment is like no other – experience diverse thinking and the rush of being among other inspired professionals in Silicon Valley. The Executive-Style MBA program may be completed in 24-36 months.

MBA-One: A unique, full-time cohort program that will help you maximize your potential quickly and with optimum ROI – allowing you to return to the workforce at a higher salary in record time. The MBA-One is an accelerated program that is completed in 12 months of intensive study. You'll be joining inspired peers who come from all parts of the nation and the globe. Classes are held at convenient times on weekdays for six, eight-week sessions. Classes meet off-campus at Techmart in Santa Clara, a meeting hub for Silicon Valley high-tech professionals. Enjoy the experience of a rigorous cohort style of learning while building relationships that will last a lifetime.

Conventional MBA: A full-time cohort program where you will thrive in the rich and vibrant atmosphere of the San José State University campus. This MBA program attracts high achievers from a variety of academic, career and cultural backgrounds.

The program begins in the Summer term in an accelerated format. During the Fall and Spring terms, courses typically meet one evening or afternoon per week during the 16-week semester cycle. A limited number of accelerated electives are available during the second Summer term. Interested in studying abroad? You may also study with partnering schools during your second Summer at the Lucas School. The Conventional MBA program may be completed in 18-24 months.

MBA/MSE Dual Degree: The Lucas School, in cooperation with the Charles W. Davidson College of Engineering, has developed an accelerated dual-degree graduate program, offering a unified MBA and a Master of Science degree in Engineering (MSE). The MBA/MSE is designed to work around the time constraints of your work-life schedule with classes held on evenings and Saturdays in accelerated eight-week cycles. Classes meet at Techmart in Santa Clara, the meeting hub for our students and professionals. The MBA/MSE program is offered in a cohort fashion, where all students take the same classes – emerging with two degrees within 34-36 months.

MS in Accountancy (MSA): An accelerated program designed for the non-accounting major which provides thorough instruction in the theory and practice of accounting. The MSA is offered once a year, starting in Summer with orientation and classes beginning in late May. The curriculum builds on a Liberal Arts, English, Mathematics, History, Foreign

Language, Sociology, Natural Science or Social Science foundation, making it one of the most unique and coveted programs that the Lucas School offers. This intensive day program is designed for full-time study, and is a cohort model, allowing students to begin together and move through the thirteen month program in unison. You will also have access to paid internship opportunities within the thirteen months of study. Classes are offered in 2-weekcycles and meet during the day on the San José State University campus. A hands-on, interdisciplinary approach makes this program one of the most innovative programs available anywhere for non-accounting majors.

MS in Taxation (MST): a program with many unique features setting it apart from other programs. The courses are scheduled to avoid classes during busy tax season times. Classes are held evenings and Saturdays in eight- to ten-week cycles with some classes online. Classes meet at Techmart in Santa Clara, a meeting hub for high-tech professionals. In addition to the required core courses, we offer over 20 elective courses. Not only is the MST program convenient, it's flexible too; choose to attend either full-time, and complete your degree in 12 months, or part time and be out in 24-36 months. Individuals who have passed the CPA exam may use that in the admission process in lieu of the GMAT. Individuals who already have an LLM (tax) or MST degree, may take five additional courses to earn an Advanced Certificate in High Tech Tax or General Taxation.
