We are very proud and excited to announce the launch of the SJSU Spartan Student Managed Real Estate Fund. The fund is seeded by CBFS and donors' money and will be managed in Spring and Fall semesters by our BUS1 172D - Student Managed Fund class students and in the Summer by our BUS1 175 - Real Estate Finance students. The fund will invest in common and preferred stocks of real estate firms, real estate investment trusts (REITs), mortgage-backed securities (MBS), real estate closed-end funds (CEFs), real estate exchange-traded Funds (ETFs) and California real estate/infrastructure municipal bonds.

NEW Master of Science in Finance Program

The Lucas Graduate School of Business is pleased to present our **newly launched Master of Science in Finance (MSF) graduate program**. The program emphasizes the knowledge necessary to succeed in corporate finance roles – teaches students to develop an evidence-based mindset and apply technical finance concepts to corporate financial planning & analysis. The course work is structured to combine accounting and finance knowledge, as well as provide experience with the relevant technology and prepare well-rounded professionals for **careers in corporate finance**. In addition to technical and analytical skills, the program emphasizes the development of communication skills, professional development, and career readiness.

The MSF program consists of 30 units. Classes are scheduled in eight week sessions in a **hybrid mode**, convenient for working professionals. The courses are offered year-round in the Fall, Spring, and Summer, and the students have the flexibility of pursuing the **full-time or part-time degree track**.
