The Mountain View High School internship program offers training and supervision to counseling interns looking to gain experience working with high school students in a collaborative and supportive environment.

Typical Activities

- Providing academic support to “at-risk” students individually or in small groups
- Identifying and offering organizational strategies to students in need
- Working with students and their families in developing postsecondary and career plans
- Gaining expertise working with school-wide data systems, such as Naviance and Aeries
- Documenting student meetings, goals and plans
- Providing socio-emotional support to students whose learning is being impacted
- Participating in Guidance Lessons presented to small groups

Qualifications

- Have completed 1st year of a PPS program
- Demonstrate strong collaboration skills
- Be flexible in the position and change direction if necessary
- Be proficient in written and oral communication skills
- Possess a big, caring heart

- Internship begins only at the beginning of a semester (Aug. or Jan.)
- Must commit to a full semester and at least 2 full days per week or 14 hours/week
