Board of Behavioral Sciences supervision is provided to qualified applicants. **Bilingual (English/Spanish) candidates HIGHLY ENCOURAGED to apply and receive an additional language differential pay if hired.**

Counselor I – Support Enhancement Services (SES)

Support and Enhancement Services (SES) reduces crime and delinquency among at risk youth and young offenders. The goal for youth served by SES is to strengthen and increase pro-social thinking patterns, beliefs, attitudes, behavior and resiliency; and to educate parents to improve their parenting skills, understand the legal consequences for their child's behavior and the court process. The overarching goal that SES seeks to accomplish is to assist youth on probation end any further involvement with the juvenile/criminal justice system. Youth are post-dispositional in the Community Release Program (CRP), Electronic Monitoring Program (EMP) or are home on probation.

Mental Health Specialist II – TAY Mental Health

The Mental Health Specialist II provides youth with case management and referral services, and preparation for independent living and also provides oversight/supervision for Mental Health Specialist I's in developing and maintaining quality services to TAY clients.
