Additional Rules for Hours		<p>Must complete a minimum of 200 hours in two different K-12 public school levels (elementary, middle school, or high school) (i.e., 200 hours at elementary + 200 hours at middle + 200 hours of student's choice)</p> <p>Of the 600 hours total:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * 150 hours must be with students of a different racial/ethnic/cultural background than the candidate * Group counseling must comprise at least 25 hours 	<p>For this section of EDCO 292, students must complete 150 hours with these requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Minimum of 90 hours in a school setting in direct contact with students * Minimum of 30 hours in interdisciplinary settings outside the field of education, such as law enforcement, juvenile justice, child health and welfare, mental health, social services, child protective services, and community-based organizations * Remaining 30 hours are at the discretion of the University Supervisor (i.e., EDCO 292 instructor) 	Students need to document direct service to clients.
