Qualifications: Ph.D. in Computer Science and teaching experience at the undergraduate level or MS in Computer Science with extensive industry and teaching experience at the undergraduate level. Applicants should have awareness of and sensitivity to the educational goals of a multicultural population as might have been gained in cross-cultural study, training, teaching and other comparable experience. Candidates should have teaching experience in the following areas: data structures and algorithms, operating systems, and computer graphics and game design.

Responsibilities:

Full time adjunct lecturers are expected to teach a course load of at least four courses per semester and fulfill all responsibilities associated with the assigned course, including conducting all assigned class meetings and weekly office hour meetings with students on campus, assigning and evaluating student work, including exams and homework assignments. Candidate must address the needs of a student population of great diversity – in age, cultural background, ethnicity, primary language and academic preparation – through course materials, teaching strategies and advisement. Other instructional or academic duties may be assigned by the Dean or the Departmental Chair.

Eligibility: Employment is contingent upon proof of eligibility to work in the United States.
