NOTES:

(1) Courses such as AMS 1A and 1B are 6 units each, for a total of 12 units, but satisfy 7 Lower Division GE Areas. Individual courses at 3 units each take a total of 21 units to meet the same requirement. This reduces the number of ANY course electives needed to reach a total of 120 units for graduation. AMS 1A and 1B are suggested, but not required.

(2) Select Econ Electives from any 4 unit upper division economics courses, there are 8 Econ Electives required for the B.A. degree. The first 4 electives must be from at least 2 different specialty areas, the remaining 4 electives can be any upper division economics course.

(3) ECON 100W can also be used to satisfy 1 of the Econ Electives and satisfy SJSU Studies Area Z.

(4) Any Course Electives give you latitude to select a minor or other courses to help you achieve outstanding Communication Skills, strong Statistical Analysis Skills, renewed Critical Thinking skills, and the ability to apply economic concepts.

* Either B1 or B2 requires a B3 lab component.
