 - (3) Select Econ Electives from any upper division economics course that is 4 units, 6 Econ Electives are required for B.S. Econ degree.
 - (4) ECON 101 and 102 should be taken as soon as possible, order does not matter. ECON 103 and 104 can be taken later. 4 upper division Economics Courses required.
 - (5) ECON 100W also satisfies one of the Econ Electives and SJSU Studies Area Z.
 - (6) Any Course Electives give you latitude to select a minor or other courses to help you achieve outstanding Communication Skills, strong Statistical Analysis Skills, renewed Critical Thinking skills, and the ability to apply economic concepts.
