

Preliminary Teaching Credential under Executive Order N-66-20 Agreement Form

On May 29, 2020, the Office of the Governor took a number of actions that assisted credential candidates impacted by the health and safety restrictions related to COVID-19. These actions were effective through August 31, 2020. These actions included postponement of assessments required for a preliminary teaching credential. On September 18, he signed SB 820, which extended these actions for an additional year. These extensions are effective through August 31, 2021.

The statutory requirement for candidates to complete the Reading Instruction Competence Assessment (RICA), and/or a Teacher Performance Assessment (TPA) for issuance of a preliminary credential are temporarily suspended and moved to Clear credential requirements. Candidates may be issued a preliminary credential without completion of RICA and/or TPA but will be required to complete the assessment in order to qualify for the Clear credential.

Written Statement Required for Candidates Postponing the RICA and/or TPA Requirement

Effective July 14, candidates applying for a preliminary credential under the Executive order will be required to submit a written statement demonstrating a COVID related testing concerns for RICA and/or TPA. The written statement could include a variety of reasons such as testing centers were closed, the candidate didn't attempt to register because they felt unsafe to be in public spaces, they were registered and/or their registration was canceled.
