- Committee members reviewed and discussed a new course proposal for EDCO 299 from the Counselor Education Department. Some suggestions were made in terms of timelines so that the IRB proposal can be submitted and approved in time. It was recommended that IRB approval be a prerequisite for EDCO 299.
- Vote to approve with the change in prerequisite: 4-0-2
- Committee members reviewed the course syllabus for the proposed Undergraduate Studies course, UNVS 96GE: Global Citizenship: A Human Perspective, developed by Maureen Smith (a committee member from CHAD). This course is one of four courses developed that have a common foundation of information and then from the perspectives of the four areas (Area B2, C2, D1, E). These courses are online and will start with up to 250 students. The committee discussed the content, assessment plans and possibilities for support from TAs to assist with grading and participation in the discussion portion of this online class.
