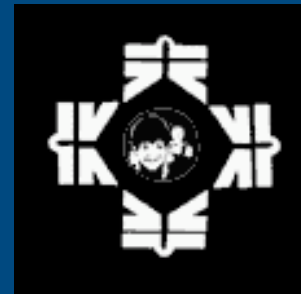

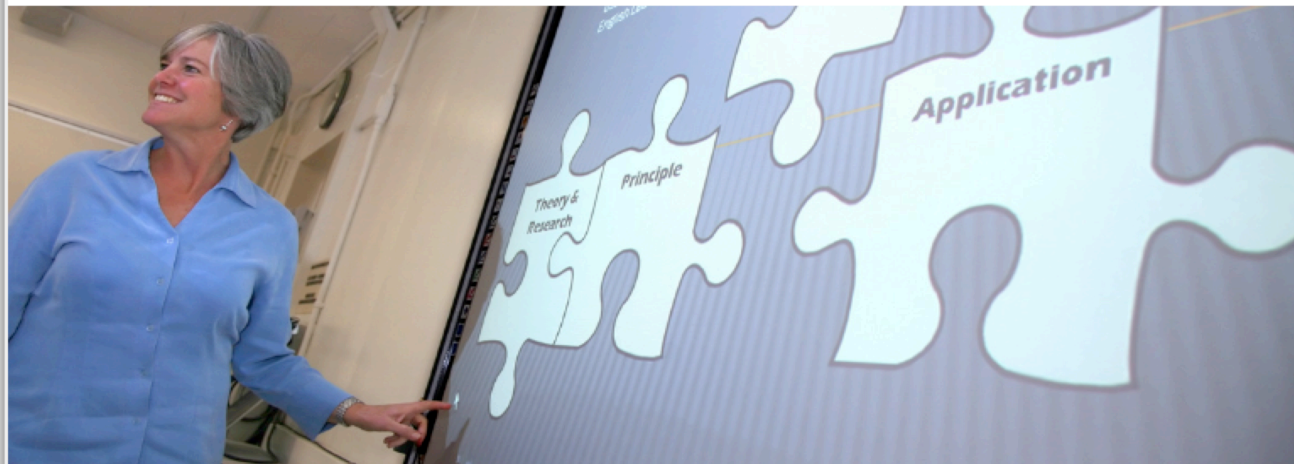

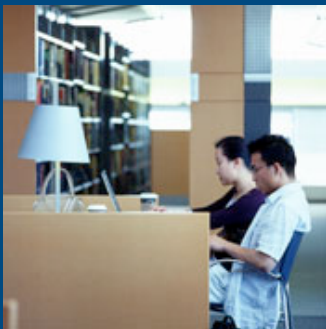

- Council of Chairs will review proposals at second monthly meeting
  - Chairs may ask Proposer to meet with them to clarify aspects of the proposal
- Chairs will forward recommendation to Dean for final decision

# Excellence in Higher Education Teaching

- Teaching - focus of our work and scholarly expertise
- Good teaching at SJSU largely defined by SOTES
- Experimentation and innovation - stifled
- Consequences for RTP
- Recognition and support for faculty

- Scholarly & critical examination of field - culture of inquiry in teaching
- Cross-college, cross-campus, cross-disciplinary investigation
- Present model to university - influence RTP process
- Model and expand ways of representing teaching in dossiers
