# Our goal: Move the College toward a Culture of Engagement

- One where....
  - Faculty members can engage in professional service that is personally satisfying and professionally coherent
  - Service connects meaningfully to the mission, goals and values of the College
  - The significance and value of that service is communicated clearly to (and appreciated by) the university community and beyond

# Service and RTP at SJSU and in the Lurie College of Education

- SJSU's current RTP policy supports a full range of service activities
- We don't need new supplemental guidelines
- We do need to help each other describe what we do in ways that convey
  - its significance
  - its rigor
  - its value



## Why People Engage...or Not

- Why College of Education faculty DO
  - Professional development/learning opportunity
  - Connected to an issue of personal significance
  - Social justice
  - Improve student experience
  
- Why College of Education faculty DON'T
  - Time constraints
  - No likely purpose or product
  - Predetermined outcomes
  - Perception of inefficiency or wasted time



# What Do We Need To Do?

- Create structures and processes to help faculty identify appropriate opportunities for service
- Eliminate barriers that discourage engagement



# Next Steps

- Annual workshop for new faculty
  - Articulate the service component of one's professional agenda
  - Articulate viable links between service, teaching and RSCA
- Mini-retreat for RTP committees
  - Articulate frameworks for recognizing the significance and value of service
- Web-based reporting structure for committees
  - Mechanism to disseminate the work of College committees
