

Terms and Conditions of Freshman Admission | Fall 2020

Provisional Admission

This offer of provisional admission is based on the academic information you reported on your Cal State Apply application and your official test scores. All of your academic information must be verified before you will be allowed to enroll and register for classes at SJSU. Your admission will remain “provisional” until your official, final transcript(s) passes verification. Some aspects of the verification process for provisional admission to the Fall 2020 term have been modified per the guidance issued by the California State University Chancellor’s Office and posted at <https://www2.calstate.edu/apply>

The required steps to verify your provisional admission and maintain your eligibility for Fall 2020 are included in this document. You may reference the Steps to Enrollment brochure included in your admission packet for more details about completing these steps -- note that information about deadlines to complete requirements included in that brochure may be modified by the information in this document.

This offer of provisional admission to the academic plan (major) listed on your admission letter is only valid for this term and may not be deferred to another semester. In addition, change of major can not be made before the beginning of the Fall 2020 semester and is not guaranteed.

Mandatory Steps to Enrollment

To satisfy the provisions of your admission and become a fully admitted student, you need to complete all of the mandatory steps in this document.

Intent to Enroll

Complete the Next Steps Intent to Enroll process by the deadline posted to your MySJSU To Do List.

To complete your Intent to Enroll by the deadline, you must sign in to <https://nextsteps.sjsu.edu> and complete each of the following steps:

- Indicate that you accept SJSU’s offer of provisional admission. Once you accept, you are making a commitment to attend SJSU and certify that you understand and agree to these terms and conditions.
- Sign up for SJSU’s mandatory Sparta Camp orientation program.
- Pay the nonrefundable fee for the mandatory enrollment deposit. Your nonrefundable enrollment deposit includes your Sparta Camp orientation payment.
- Within 24 hours an email confirmation will be sent to you from the nextsteps@sjsu.edu email address. Print and keep this email—it is your Next Steps receipt for orientation.
- Questions for concerns with completing the multi-step Intent to Enroll process should be directed to nextsteps@sjsu.edu

Provisional Admission Verification for Fall 2020 ONLY

Your official, final transcript(s) must show that you meet the current impactation criteria and the CSU minimum requirements for freshman admission in order to pass final verification. Failure to pass final verification will result in your admission being withdrawn.

- Confirm the completion of all of your A-G college preparatory coursework with a grade of “C-” or better by the end of Spring 2020. For Fall 2020 admitted students only, SJSU will accept grades of “Credit” or “Pass” to satisfy “A-G” requirements completed during winter, spring or summer 2020 terms. All coursework completed prior to Spring 2020 must be graded and a grade of C- or better must be earned for the course to satisfy “A-G” requirements. Grades of Credit/No Credit or Pass/No Pass coursework will not be included in our calculation of your final high school GPA.
- Confirm your date of high school graduation.
- Confirm you meet the minimum eligibility index and impactation standards for your major.

Submitting Official Transcripts

SJSU requests the submission of official, final, high school transcript(s), including grades for the Spring 2020 term and date of graduation, no later than Wednesday, July 15, 2020.

This transcript must be official and include your date of high school graduation. If you completed coursework that is not reflected on your high school transcript, you must also send final, official transcripts that include your final grades no later than Wednesday, July 15, 2020.

For Fall 2020 admission only, SJSU will not rescind admission for non-receipt of transcripts by the July 15 deadline.

Send official test scores needed to fulfill admission requirements

If you have taken and passed AP, IB or CLEP exams to satisfy any of the CSU admission requirements, request that your official scores be sent so they are received by July 15.

Monitor your MySJSU account

You can avoid your admission being withdrawn by carefully and frequently monitoring your MySJSU account (one.sjsu.edu) throughout the entire admission process. We reserve the right to rescind your admission for noncompliance to the conditions stated in your admission materials at any time during the process.

You must meet all deadlines and conditions of your admission. Failure to do so will result in your admission being withdrawn, even if you have received financial aid, signed up for housing, attended orientation, or registered for classes.
