

Terms and Conditions of Freshman Admission | Fall 2015

Provisional Admission

This offer of provisional admission is based on the academic information you reported on your CSUMentor application. All of your academic information must be verified before you will be allowed to enroll and register for classes at SJSU. Your admission will remain “provisional” until your official, final transcript passes verification.

This offer of provisional admission to the academic plan (major) listed on your admission letter is only valid for this term and may not be deferred to another semester. In addition, it is not possible to change your major prior to enrollment at SJSU.

Mandatory Steps to Enrollment

You must meet all deadlines and conditions of your admission. Failure to do so will result in your admission being withdrawn, even if you have received financial aid, signed up for housing, attended orientation, or registered for classes.

To satisfy the provisions of your admission and become a fully admitted student, you need to complete all of the mandatory steps in this document.

Complete the intent to enroll process by Friday, May 1, 2015

You must sign in to <https://nextsteps.sjsu.edu> and complete the multi-step Intent to Enroll process by 11:59 p.m. PST, Friday, May 1, 2015. Indicate that you accept SJSU’s offer of “provisional” admission. Once you accept, you are making a commitment to attend SJSU and certify that you understand and agree to these terms and conditions.

- Sign up for all required placement exams. See the *Steps to Enrollment* brochure included in your admissions packet for more details regarding test dates and required exams.
- Sign up for a mandatory Frosh Orientation session. Once you choose a session date, it cannot be changed.
- Pay the \$250.00 nonrefundable orientation fee.
- Wait 3-5 business days. A confirming email will be sent to you from the nextsteps@sjsu.edu email address. Print and keep this email—it is your Next Steps receipt.

If you do not complete the multi-step Intent to Enroll Process by the May 1 deadline, we will withdraw your application. See the *Steps to Enrollment* brochure included in your admission packet for more details regarding the Intent to Enroll process.

Entry Level Mathematics (ELM) and English Placement Test (EPT) Requirements

You must satisfy the ELM and EPT requirements before you can register for classes. Step two of the Next Steps Intent to Enroll process will indicate if you are required to take the ELM, the EPT, or both exams. You must take any required placement exams by Saturday, May 2, 2015, or you will not be allowed to enroll in the Fall 2015 term and must reapply to a future term.

Send your official, final high school transcript, including grades for the Spring 2015 term, postmarked no later than Wednesday, July 15, 2015.

This transcript must include your date of high school graduation. If you completed coursework that is not reflected on your high school transcript, you must also send final, official transcripts that include your final grades no later than Wednesday, July 15, 2015.

Meet the CSU minimum requirements for freshman admission

An internal review (verification) of your application will be conducted. Your official, final transcript(s) must show that you meet the current impactation criteria and freshman admission requirements in order to pass verification. Failure to pass verification will result in your admission being withdrawn.

To ensure your provisional admission passes verification, make sure your official, final transcript meets the following criteria:

- Confirm the completion of all of your A-G college preparatory coursework with a grade of “C-” or better by the end of Spring 2015.
- Confirm your date of graduation.

Send official test scores needed to fulfill admission requirements

If you have taken AP exams to satisfy any of the CSU admission requirements, contact College Board immediately and request that your official scores be sent to SJSU.

If required, sign up for University Housing at housing.sjsu.edu or the International House at sjsu.edu/ihouse

Monitor your MySJSU account to avoid the cancellation of your admission

You can avoid your admission being withdrawn by carefully and frequently monitoring your MySJSU account (<http://my.sjsu.edu>) throughout the entire admission process. We reserve the right to rescind your admission for noncompliance to the conditions stated in your admission materials at any time during the process.

Change of Major

Because of SJSU’s campus-wide impactation status, students who were assigned to the Undeclared major or wish to change majors will follow the process outlined at sjsu.edu/advising/change_of_major. Change of major cannot be made before the beginning of the Fall 2015 semester and is not guaranteed.
