

Terms and Conditions of Lower Division Transfer Admission Spring 2019

Provisional Admission

This offer of provisional admission is based on the academic information you reported on your Cal State Apply application. All of your academic information must be verified before you will be allowed to enroll and register for classes at SJSU. Your admission will remain “provisional” until you meet all terms stated below and your official, final transcript pass verification. This offer of provisional admission to the academic plan (major) listed on your admission letter is only valid for this term and may not be deferred to another semester. In addition, it is not possible to change your major prior to enrollment at SJSU.

To satisfy the provisions of your admission and become a fully admitted student, you need to complete all of the mandatory steps below:

Complete the Next Steps Intent to Enroll process by Saturday, December 1, 2018 (11:59 pm PST).

Complete the following steps in the Intent to Enroll process on the Next Steps website (<https://nextsteps.sjsu.edu/spring>) by **December 1**.

1. Indicate that you accept SJSU’s offer of “provisional” admission. Once you “accept,” you are making a commitment to attend SJSU and certify that you understand and agree to these terms and conditions.
2. Sign up for mandatory orientation.
3. Pay the non-refundable \$250 Enrollment Deposit.
4. An email confirmation will be sent to you within 24 hours from the nextsteps@sjsu.edu email address. Print and keep this email—it is your Next Steps receipt.

If you do not complete the entire Intent to Enroll process by December 1, we will withdraw your application. Please contact nextsteps@sjsu.edu before the deadline if you have any problems completing these steps.

Send your official, final high school and college transcript(s) (including grades for the Summer term) postmarked no later than the date posted on your MySJSU “To Do List”.

High school transcripts must include your date of high school graduation. If you completed coursework that is not reflected on your high school transcript, you must also send final, official transcripts.

Meet the CSU Minimum Requirements for freshman admission

An internal review (verification) of your application will be conducted. Your official, final transcript(s) must show that you meet the current impactation criteria and freshman admission requirements in order to pass verification. Failure to pass verification will result in your admission being withdrawn.

To ensure your provisional admission passes verification, make sure your official, final transcript(s) meet the following criteria:

- Confirm the completion of all of your A-G college preparatory coursework with a grade of “C-” or higher by the end of Summer 2018.
- Confirm your date of graduation.
- Earn a minimum of 2.0 in all college coursework
- Send official test scores needed to fulfill admission requirements.
- If you have taken AP exams to satisfy any of the CSU admission requirements, contact College Board immediately and request that your official scores be sent to SJSU.

Monitor MySJSU

SJSU communicates almost entirely by messages and “To Do List” items posted to your MySJSU Student Center. Check MySJSU frequently for updates to your status, important messages, and invitations to upcoming events. You are responsible for compliance with all deadlines posted on MySJSU. Failure to do so may result in your application or admission being withdrawn even if you have signed up for housing, attended orientation, or registered for Spring 2019 classes.

Attend Orientation

If you do not attend or leave during any portion of orientation you will not be able to attend SJSU in Spring 2019.

Sign up for Campus Housing

If required, sign up for campus housing at sjsu.edu/housing or International House at sjsu.edu/ihouse.

Change of Major

Because of SJSU’s campus-wide impactation status, students who wish to change major will follow the directions provided by the Office of the Registrar sjsu.edu/registrar/students/change_of_major/ Change of major can not be made before the beginning of the Spring 2019 semester and is not guaranteed.
