1 EOP TOWN HALL & SURVEY

Every semester, all EOP students are required to attend the EOP Town Hall or watch recorded webinar.

- If you were unable to attend the live event, you will need to view the recorded Town Hall webinar and submit the EOP Town Hall Survey by **Tuesday, 8/31/21** in order to meet this requirement.

2 EOP ADVISING

All first year EOP Frosh students are required to meet with the assigned EOP Academic Advisor twice in the fall semester.

- You will be sent two appointment campaigns:
 - 1st advising appointment: **9/1 - 10/8**
 - 2nd advising appointment: **10/11 - 11/12**
- Deadline to complete mandatory advising: **Friday, 11/12/21.**
- Appointment campaigns for required EOP advising will be sent via Spartan Connect on 8/23/21 and again on 10/1/21.

3 EOP WORKSHOPS & SURVEYS

All EOP students are required to complete two (2) Student Lingo online workshops AND submit two (2) EOP Workshop Surveys by Friday, 11/12/21.

- Please note that the survey at the end of the Student Lingo workshop is **NOT** the same as the EOP Survey.

4 EOP MENTORING (NSM, ICIW, OR ACES)

NSM MENTORING:

- All New Freshmen are required to participate in either the New Student Mentor (NSM) or I Can/I Will (ICIW) program in the first year.

ICIW MENTORING:

- All New Freshmen and Transfers are required to participate in either the I Can/I Will (ICIW) program in their first year. ICIW is specifically for Latino and African American males.

ACES MENTORING:

- Continuing EOP students with a cumulative SJSU GPA between 2.00 – 2.300 are required to participate in the ACES (Academic Coaching for Educational Success) program this semester.
