EOP students are involved in their education, and enhance the skills necessary to successfully achieve their personal, professional, and academic goals while in college and beyond.

1. EOP TOWN HALL (TH) & SURVEY

2. EOP PAGES

All EOP students must attend and complete three (3) SJSU campus/center events (in-person or virtual) AND then submit three (3) EOP Fall 2023 PAGES Surveys this semester, by the deadline: **Fri. 11/17**

There is a variety of on campus (in-person and virtual) events that will enhance your personal and professional development. Student engagement in their educational process is crucial to their future academic and personal success.

Complete one (1) event in each of the following categories:

- **Professional:** SJSU Career Center sponsored events, fairs, online tutorials, and other career related resources
- **Academic:** Peer Connections, Writing Center, MLK Library, and Study Abroad sponsored events
- **Personal:** events of your choosing that support your college experience; Weeks of Welcome, Spartan Speaker Series, LinkedIn Learning, Student Success units, just to name a few

Major/Success Center advising, GE advising, tutoring, SJSU/EOP peer mentoring, sporting events, or off-campus (non-SJSU) events do not fill this requirement

3. EOP STUDENT SUCCESS ADVISING

First-year EOP Transfers are required to meet with an EOP Advisor once in the fall, and once in the spring semester

- EOP drop-in advising, GE, Major, or Success Center advising does not count towards required EOP advising
- EOP required advising appointments will be held **Tue. 9/5 - Fri. 11/17**
- Be sure to complete your EOP required advising by **Fri. 11/17**
