PAGEs FAQs

What is EOP PAGEs?

PAGEs is an acronym for Personal and Academic Growth Experiences. PAGEs encompass SJSU in-person or virtual campus events

Why do I need to complete PAGEs?

EOP requirements support student's growth and sense of belonging by connecting them with EOP services and SJSU Campus Resources Students involved in their education develop the skills necessary to successfully achieve their personal, professional, and academic goals

Why is PAGEs important?

Student engagement in their educational process is crucial to their future academic and personal success

There are many campus events (in-person and virtual) that will enhance your personal and professional development

What are the PAGEs categories?

Professional (Career), Academic, and Personal

How do I complete the PAGEs requirement?

- **STEP 1:** All EOP students are required to complete at least one (1) separate event (in-person or virtual) in each of the following categories: Academic, Professional (Career), and Personal
- STEP 2: Submit three (3) EOP Fall 2023 PAGEs Surveys, one for each event

What are some types of events that would be acceptable to complete in each category?

- PROFESSIONAL: SJSU Career Center sponsored events, fairs, online tutorials, and other career related resources
- ACADEMIC: Peer Connections, Writing Center, MLK Library, and Study Abroad sponsored events
- **PERSONAL:** Events of your choosing that support your college experience; EOP events, Weeks of Welcome, Spartan Speaker Series, LinkedIn Learning, Student Success units, just to name a few

Are these the only department sponsored events I can attend for the Professional or Academic categories?

No. You are able to attend other career or academic related events on campus, as some majors/other departments may hold events as well

Can I complete 2 Professional events from the Career Center?

Yes! One of the Career Center events would fall under the Professional category, and the second event will fall under the Personal category

What is the deadline to complete at least 3 PAGEs events and 3 PAGEs Surveys?

The deadline is Friday, November 17, 2023







PAGEs FAQs

Is the PAGEs Survey the same as the Town Hall Survey?

No, these are separate surveys and separate EOP requirements

I am a Continuing EOP 2nd year+ student, do I need to complete PAGEs?

Yes. All EOP students, new and continuing, are required to complete the minimum of three (3) PAGEs events and three (3) PAGEs surveys

Where do I find SJSU campus events that will meet the PAGEs requirement?

The best place to find events on campus is by going to the department website directly

- PROFESSIONAL: the Career Center website
- ACADEMIC: the MLK Library, Peer Connections, Study Abroad, and Writing Center websites
- PERSONAL: EOP, Student Involvement and Campus Partner websites
 - o The SJSU's Event calendar lists most campus wide events, and also has a filter for specific dates and types of events: events.sjsu.edu
 - Be sure to check out the "events" section on the Sammy App and department social media accounts as well

What events DO NOT meet this requirement?

Major advising, Success Center advising, GE advising, tutoring, SJSU or EOP peer mentoring, sporting events, Student Organization tabling events, CAPS appointments, or off-campus (non-SJSU) events

Will I receive a confirmation after I submit the PAGEs Survey?

Please download the PDF of your responses at completion of the survey, and email the PDF to your SJSU email for your records
A confirmation email from EOP is not automatic, and we will send confirmations on an ongoing basis
Be sure to enter your correct SJSU ID, as incorrect IDs will not receive a confirmation from EOP, nor receive credit for this requirement
