is dedicated to increasing access and academic excellence to first-generation college students by offering intentional and holistic support services as well as multifaceted community engagement.


EOP provides services that support your academic, career, financial, professional, and personal growth by offering:

- A dedicated EOP advisor assigned to you
- Summer Bridge Program for first-year frosh
- Variety of mentoring programs
- EOP Grant awarded to eligible students

Applicants must be considered CA Residents or AB540, historically low-income, and whose parents have not earned a 4-year degree.

EOP acceptance can only occur at the time of admission to SJSU/CSU, check CSU EOP deadlines at calstate.edu/eop

SJSU Admission

Apply to SJSU between **October 1-November 30** through Cal State Apply.

2

EOP Admission

Apply to EOP by **November 30** for priority consideration through Cal State Apply, with a final deadline of **January 15**.

3

Recommendation Forms

Submit two (2) recommendation forms by **January 31** through Cal State Apply.

4

FAFSA/CA Dream Act

Submit the FAFSA or CA Dream Act application to SJSU by **January 31**. SJSU school code: **001155**

I've Applied, Now What?

- Check your MySJSU messages weekly
- Track your recommendation forms through Cal State Apply
- SJSU EOP admission decisions are sent out in April

Did You Know?

The EOP application must be submitted at the same time as the CSU Admission Application.
