- Please submit one EOP PAGES Survey form for EACH event.
- EOP uses your SJSU ID to send you a confirmation of your survey completion. Be sure to enter it correctly, as your confirmation is your proof of completion of your PAGES requirement.
- **The EOP PAGES survey is due: Friday, April 28, 2023, by 11:59pm.**

**Note: At the end of the survey, it will give you the option to download a PDF of your response. Please download a copy to keep for your records.**

- Be sure to enter your correct SJSU ID# to receive a confirmation
- An EOP confirmation will be sent to you in approximately 3-4 weeks

- After each survey submission, download the PDF of your responses to keep for your records.

**03****CONTINUING /  
RETURNING STUDENTS**

- **1X PER SEMESTER IF SJSU GPA IS BETWEEN 0.0 - 2.2**
- Advising must be completed between Feb. 6 - April 28



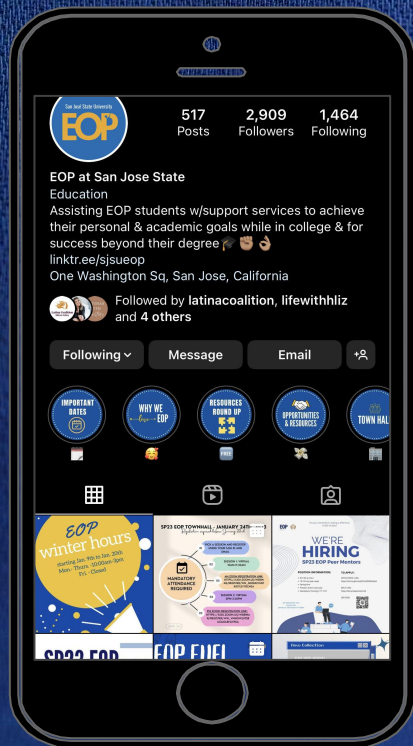
