Instructions for Essay 6

For essay six, you will have the opportunity to significantly revise essay 5 and add a research component. You should take some time to think about the comments made on your first drafts (comments made by your peers and by me). Your next draft should really re-visualize your argument in light of these comments, and your drafts should be substantially edited and reorganized. Make sure you have a clear, concise thesis statement, and that you develop your argument throughout your paper by using evidence from the text.

Essay six must also incorporate at least 5 secondary texts, at least two of these should be about the fictional text that is your subject; one or two may be about the theory you employ. Appropriate secondary texts include: articles from scholarly journals, books, or book chapters. While you might use the internet to locate paper sources, I would advise against using internet sources themselves unless you have carefully evaluated the credibility of the site (refer to Barnett, Chapter 15, pages 333-334).

You must also use proper MLA format (guidelines in Barnett, Chapter 15), with a Works Cited page listing all of the texts that appear in your essay. An example of a correctly formatted Works Cited page is on Barnett, page 331.

This assignment is due **on May 16th**, the last day of class. Late papers **WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**.

Your folder or packet should contain the following:

1. Your revised essay
2. Your graded draft (essay 5)
3. Two peer review sheet completed by your classmates
