FINAL PROJECT

Your final 15-page essay will be based on a topic of your choosing that incorporates Romantic-era literature and the themes we've been discussing in class. You also have the option to create a digital project in consultation with me. (A digital project does not mean that you can skip writing!)

Due Dates:

3/23 First Draft (4pp max) and Annotated Bibliography (4 articles min) – EMAIL BY 5PM

The First Draft is a proposal of your topic and should include descriptions of how research will be / is incorporated into your argument. Include a section on further research goals, e.g., what themes, articles, essays or books you will continue to research. This draft should contain the beginnings of your argument. You will receive comments back from me to help guide you.

The Annotated Bibliography should consist of 4 articles. Each article entry should contain: a bibliographic entry, a summary, a critique and the article's application to your argument. See our class Annotated Bibliography for hints and links to sources on writing Annotated Bibliographies.

5/18 Final Draft (15pp max), Annotated Bibliography (10 articles min) and Abstract

An Abstract of your Final Essay should be posted to our course listserv by 5pm on 5/17. In addition, email a copy of your Annotated Bibliography to me by 5/17 at 5pm. This will be posted on our course Website.

Bring a paper copy of all three documents for discussion on 5/18. I am available to read drafts, discuss topics and give suggestions for research. Any digital projects will be posted to our course Website.
