#### I. PD Updates

## II. Summer Workshop

## III. Calculus Study

- Shandy updated the campus leads with the current status of the Calculus Study:
  - There are current issues with the survey distribution and operation of it.
  - Student supervision is not appropriate.
  - Faculty are being forced to mark which surveys are flipped and which ones are "business as usual".
  - Taking longer than 8 10 minutes estimated. Need to improve before next round.

## IV. APR Update

- Was due on March 23<sup>rd</sup>, however with the current situation concerning the APR for the last grant year we have extended time to complete it.
- Need to review the three campuses budgets, to get a new approved budget from ED so that we are in compliance with the under-spending.
- The current leftover funding will go to AY workshops, additional mini-grants, and additional support for Calculus study faculty for development.

- Keep up the momentum of faculty interest and involvement during the last year.
