



COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES (CAPS)

CAPS continues to operate all services remotely. Students can receive services by calling the main line at (408) 924-5910 during operational hours from Monday - Thursday, 8:30 AM - 5:30 PM and Friday 8:30 AM - 4:30 PM. Services are being provided either by phone or video conference, utilizing Zoom Health for video sessions - a secure, encrypted, HIPAA compliant service.

After-hour crisis intervention services continue to be available by calling the main line at (408) 924-5910, and selecting option 4. Psychiatric services are available Tuesday - Thursday, by calling the Student Health Center appointment line at (408) 924-6122.

CALIFORNIA COLLEGE STUDENT EMERGENCY SUPPORT FUND

The California College Student Emergency Support Fund has launched to give onetime \$500 hardship grants to students. This program is administered by the Mission Asset Fund which assesses emergency needs for low-income college students, including undocumented immigrants, foster youth, and students who are housing insecure.

To be eligible, you must:

- Be currently enrolled full-time (12+ units) as an undergraduate at a California Community College, California State University, or University of California campus
- Have earned at least 24 semester units or 36 quarter units (i.e., one academic year of coursework)
- Be low-income, with a maximum Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) of \$5,576 (from your FAFSA or CA Dream application) or eligible for a California College Promise Grant Fee Waiver (formerly known as the BOG fee waiver)

GREEK AWARDS


