In this chapter, the authors examine the complexity of global leaders themselves. As global leadership research has begun to move beyond a limiting overemphasis on skills and competencies, they merge one focus on the deep structure of leader cognition with a focus on cultural identity that has matured largely independently. In so doing, they seek to push the field toward answering the broader question of what makes a global leader sufficiently complex to handle the vast complexities of the role.
