

## **MINOR IN AREA STUDIES (15 UNITS)**

A minor in Area Studies consists of 15 units, selected in consultation with an advisor. The student will concentrate his or her studies in one of the following regions: Africa and the Middle East, Asia, Latin America, or Europe. Programs of study for other regions must be worked out in consultation with the advisor.

The student must complete 9-12 units in one area and 3-6 units in general courses.

Appropriate independent study (courses numbered 180 and 184) may count toward the minor where the study builds on a regular course the student has already taken. Courses taken while in a foreign country may also be counted where appropriate. Neither course taken to satisfy requirements in the major nor any lower division courses may be counted toward the 15 units for the minor. Although these do not count toward the minor, the student is urged to take lower division G.E. courses in Comparative Politics (PoIS 2), International Relations (PoIS 4), Cultural Anthropology (Anth 11), Cultural Geography (Geog 10), World History (Hist 1AB) and Western Civilization (Hist 10AB). Students are also urged to study at least one modern foreign language.

International Business Majors may use only one course in Area Studies for Advanced G.E. In the listings below, all G.E. courses have been marked with an asterisk.
