LOWER DIVISION COURSES: 12 units

REQUIRED: HIST 1A + HIST 1B World History (3 + 3)

or

HIST 10A + HIST 10B Western Civilization (GE Area D2) (3 + 3)

REQUIRED: HIST 15 + POLS 15 U.S. History & Government (GE Area US1-2-3 & D2-3) (3 + 3)

or

HIST 20A + HIST 20B History of the American People (GE Area US1) (3 + 3)

CORE COURSES: 10 units

REQUIRED: HIST 99 History Fundamentals (3)

HIST 100W Writing Workshop (prerequisites: HIST 99 & WST) (SJSU Studies Area Z) (3)

HIST 102 Historiography (prerequisite: HIST 100W) (4)

UPPER DIVISION COURSES: 28 units*

REQUIRED: SEVEN upper-division courses as follows:

• TWO courses from one field

- TWO courses from a second field
- ONE course from a third field
- TWO courses from any field

Among these SEVEN courses, you need at least TWO Advanced Topics courses (any fields) and at least TWO pre-1750 courses.

*Students who take HIST 153, 155, 185, and/or 188 may graduate with fewer than 50 total units and fewer than 28 upper-division units in the major because HIST 153, 155, 185, and 188 are 3-unit courses. See the History undergraduate advisor for details.
