





File structures.




Important user interface elements







Adding and sequencing footage

- Create a new sequence and arrange footage, images, graphics in sequential order that you want the video to render them in.
- Drag items around the timeline to rearrange their position on the timeline.
- Items on different tracks will overlap. For example PNG's will retain transparencies overlapping video footage, and overlapping audio tracks will play on top of each other.












Adding text and shapes.

- Add shapes using the Shapes tool.










Keyframes


Animate elements by changing specific properties like size, opacity, etc. over time. For instance, animating our title created above by having it slide into the video.


Keyframes can be used in almost anything you can think of in Premiere Pro. Text, graphics, even footage can be animated in position, opacity, scale, etc.
















Generating, and editing transcripts


Your own narration can be used to generate a transcript inside Premiere Pro. For the purposes of educational demonstration - I will be using audio from *This American Life*.


You can even export standalone subtitles to import into Youtube (vs. auto generated subtitles).


