Meal Plans are optional for all non-frosh living in the apartments. UHS will not assign a spring meal plan to non-frosh unless it is requested by the resident. If you would like to add a meal plan for the spring semester, select one of the available plans from the drop down box below.

The spring semester housing due date, or the first installment if you are on the Housing Installment Payment Plan, is Tuesday, December 10, 2019. The additional charges for your added meal plan will be applied to your student account prior to the December 10, 2019 due date.

If you are undecided about a meal plan, you may add one later; however, the installment options may be limited depending on when the plan is added. In addition, you will be required to come into the Housing main office to make this request in writing.

Along with the rebate, Spartan Power, Spartan Plus and Max Plan holders will receive a 10% discount on all bottled beverages purchased during the Spring 2020 semester on campus (beginning February 11, 2020). Visit The Commons office for more details.

*Eligible plans must be purchased before February 11, 2020 and be currently active to be eligible for the rebate and bottled beverage discount. Rebates will be credited towards the resident's Tower Card account no later than February 13, 2020.

Gold points can be used at any Spartan Eats dining location on campus and the Spartan Bookstore and will roll over to the next school year if unused.

SPARTAN FLEX MEAL PLAN - The Spartan Flex Plan is NOT eligible for the rebate program.

Dining Dollars do NOT roll over to the next academic year.

Please note that the final day to downgrade (switch from a higher priced meal plan to a lower priced meal plan) and/or cancel an optional meal plan for the spring semester is Tuesday,

February 11, 2020 and you will be required to come into the Housing main office to initiate the change. No meal plan downgrades and/or cancellations will be processed after this date.
