

University Housing Services is committed to providing a safe and healthy living environment for all residents. We are taking the recent increase in reported cases of Coronavirus (COVID-19) in Santa Clara County very seriously. The health and well-being of our residents is our top priority.

In response, University Housing Services is taking a number of actions addressing the Coronavirus (COVID-19) and/or the flu in the United States. We continue to clean and sanitize as many public spaces including door knobs, bathroom sinks and showers, and elevator buttons, etc. to minimize the spread of COVID-19 as well as other diseases, such as the flu.

Other efforts include:

- Custodial staff are doing extra cleaning around common areas including wiping down door knobs, crash bars on doors and elevator buttons
- Hand sanitizer stations will be placed in all elevator lobbies and at the front desk of each building
- Sanitizer misters are being purchased to provide additional cleaning

In addition, we are restricting the number of guests residents are permitted to host. All residents will be allowed to host no more than one guest at a time. Further, each guest must be registered 24/7 at the hosting resident's building front desk.

As advised by the Center for Disease Control (CDC, see link below), all residents and their guests are encouraged to wash their hands more frequently than usual which will help to prevent the spread of any germs or viruses.
