



Welcome to Fall 2017 Residence Hall Opening at San José State University!

We are excited to have you move on campus and hope you will have a wonderful year! Residence Hall Move-in is Saturday, August 19th, so we are sending you some important information to help ease your move and check-in to campus housing!

Check-In

On Saturday, August 19th, all residents will check-in at the SJSU Event Center between 9am and 6pm, and then be directed to their specific building to unload. If you are moving in on Saturday evening, between 7pm and 10pm or on Sunday, August 20th between 1pm and 5pm or 7pm to 10pm, you may go directly to your assigned building to check in.

We encourage Returning Residents to consider checking in during the evening hours to avoid lines and potential delays as we expect our daytime check in hours to be extremely busy.

Please remember to **bring your room assignment information** and SJSU Tower card, Driver's License, Passport, or State ID. **If you have not received your SJSU Tower Card, please bring your SJSU Student ID number.**

Parking

Parking will be available free of charge in the following designated locations:

Washburn, Joe West and CV2 Resident Parking - South (7th Street) Garage

Please exit from I-280 onto 7th Street heading north. Park in the South Garage (377 S Seventh St)

CVA and CVB Apartments and CVC Suites Resident Parking - Campus Village Parking Garage

Please exit from 280 South/680 North on to 11th Street. Take 11th Street to East San Carlos Street. Turn left on to East San Carlos Street then left again on to 10th Street. Entrance to the CV Parking Garage (350 South 9th Street) will be on your right.

In the Campus Village Parking Garage, the P1 level will be designated for unloading purposes only. After unloading, we ask that you move your vehicle to the P2 level. If there are no more spaces on the P2 level, you may park in the 7th Street garage. The Campus Village Parking Garage will close at 10:30pm on Saturday, August 19th, and Sunday, August 20th.

All oversize vehicles will be directed to park in Lot 4 located near the intersection of San Fernando and 10th Streets. The entrance is off of 10th Street. Oversize vehicles are not permitted in the Campus Village or South (7th Street) Garage.

San Salvador Street

Parking spaces along San Salvador Street will be designated as unloading areas only. You may park for up to 30 minutes in these spaces prior to moving your vehicle to the 7th Street or CV Parking garage.

- ❖ Once you park, on Saturday, August 19th, follow the signs to the SJSU Event Center where you will Check in and receive your access card, Room Inventory Sheet, and information packet. We ask that you check in prior to

unloading and do not bring your belongings to the Event Center. If you're moving in on Sunday, August 20th, please go directly to your assigned building once you park.

- ❖ At your check in location, you may pick up an unloading permit as needed.
- ❖ Residents of the Apartments, CVC Suites, Joe West and Washburn Halls may pick up their hard key at their building front desk after checking in at the Event Center. Residents of CV2 will not receive a hard key as the building and room doors are card access.
- ❖ On Saturday, August 19th, we will have volunteers available to assist you with the unloading and moving-in. **We suggest you bring a hand truck.**



- ❖ On Saturday, August 19th, we invite you to attend one of the Family Welcome programs at 11am or 4pm in the Student Union Theater. We look forward to welcoming you to the Spartan Family and sharing information about Residential Life, campus resources and ways to help your student succeed at SJSU.

- ❖ **MicroFridges** are still available to rent for the academic year.

- ❖ San José State University strongly recommends **Grad Guard Renters Insurance** for all students.
