**Call for Applications:
SJSU HRI and ISSSSC Human Rights and Social Change Awards (2020-21 AY)**

Each year the SJSU Human Rights Institute [HRI] and Institute for the Study of Sport, Society, and Social Change [ISSSSC] will give an award to one SJSU student (undergrad or grad), one SJSU faculty member (any rank), and one community organization or stakeholder for their work as human rights scholars and/or change agents. **Award recipients will be announced and recognized at the 2021 HRI/ISSSSC Spring Research Colloquium on Human Rights and Social Change, on April 27th (2:00-5:00).**

To nominate a student, faculty member, or community organization/stakeholder for this year's SJSU Human Rights and Social Change Award, **please submit a one page nomination letter** that (1) describes the work and/or recent achievements of the student, faculty member, or community organization/stakeholder; (2) describes how their work and/or recent achievements relate to our understanding of human rights crises, contribute to their solutions, or affect necessary social change for human rights practice. **Self-nominations are welcome.** Any links to publications, websites, or other research products should be included in these letters if possible. Applications will be reviewed by the Spring Research Colloquium committee, consisting of members from both the HRI and ISSSSC.
