 - 2) Identify and describe any volunteer work, internship, or other work experience in the criminal or juvenile justice field.
 - 3) How will this scholarship contribute to your academic success and professional goals?
- III. For the Hoover and Schmidt scholarships, you must submit either a 500-750 word essay or a 3-5 minute video in which you respond to the assignment for that particular scholarship.
- IV. For the Paula Stone Hubbell Scholarship, submit a letter of recommendation from a professional in the field.
