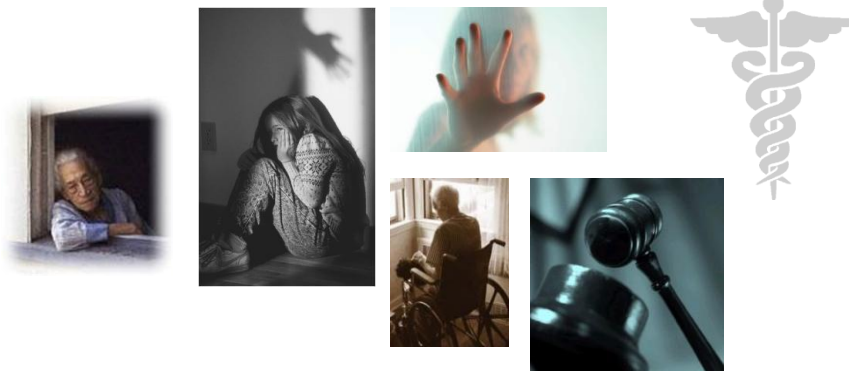

#### TRAINING IN COLLABORATION

The goal of the Institute for Collaborative Response (ICR) is to provide a new model of education and training that will inspire students to work collaboratively among related disciplines to provide a more effective response for victims of family violence. Students who participate in the Institute will receive specialized training in areas of victimization, awareness of victims' rights, and models for collaborative practice and service delivery.

#### INTERSHIPS

Students will participate in cross-discipline internship experiences through their respective departments as well as special interdisciplinary trainings sponsored by ICR. Through participation in ICR, students will learn to respond jointly to the issues and needs of family violence victims and help enhance the delivery of services. As a participant in this innovative program, you will learn state of the art interventions in diverse settings in the context of a coordinated community response for victims of family violence and with professionals who possess expertise in this process of collaborative practice.

#### CERTIFICATE

Through your participation in ICR, you will earn a certificate of completion in Collaborative Response from the College of Applied Sciences and Arts Dean's office, contributing to your training, skills and résumé.

- Attending special workshops on collaboration, understanding aspects of coordinated community response and interdisciplinary response to victims of family violence.
- Participating in special interdisciplinary discussion groups
- Working in qualified collaborative field placements
- Completing a special project that reflects your collaborative experience
