## SPEED SCREENING:

Find out if your criminal convictions are eligible to be dismissed. To be eligible to dismiss a conviction for which you were sentenced to jail or probation, California law requires that you:

- Not be on probation
- Not be charged with any offense
- Not be serving time for any offense
- Not have any unpaid restitution (money due to the victim)

To find out whether your conviction(s) can be dismissed, come for a free, one-on-one interview with a student, supervised by an attorney. Please bring your rap sheet or background check report.

## EMPLOYMENT RIGHTS AND CRIMINAL RECORDS :

Learn what employees can consider and why employer rules barring all people with convictions are illegal. An attorney from the National Employment Law Project will present information regarding employment laws affecting people with criminal histories.
