

Department of Kinesiology Scholar Awards for Undergraduate Students

The annual Department of Kinesiology Scholar Award honors students from each major area within the department, Kinesiology, Physical Education Teacher Education, and Athletic Training. Students whose academic and leadership records are distinctive are recognized through this annual award. The awards are intended to recognize and promote academic excellence, to further the professional competence and dedication of academically accomplished students and to promote kinesiology and its related fields. Applicants for the Scholar Award are also **eligible for submission to the AKA student awards** (see <http://www.americankinesiology.org/SubPages/Pages/Scholar%20Awards>) and other on-campus honors.

Criteria (must meet all, please check to indicate yes)

- Senior with an exceptional GPA, minimum overall 3.6
- Student graduating in the 2017-2018 academic year
- Demonstrates exceptional scholarly interest in the field of kinesiology

Applications are **DUE February 21th, 2018** and must include:

- Completed application form;
- A two page vita (NOT to exceed two pages) including GPA and information related to scholarly interest/accomplishments, leadership, and service to the profession;
- A 250-300 word narrative describing the applicant's academic accomplishments and information related to award criteria;
- Email digital photo of student (Preferably 400 x 600 pixel JPG)

Guidelines for Narrative for scholar award

- Commitment to high levels of academic accomplishment
- Engagement with professional or academic organizations
- Demonstration of academic excellence across the discipline
