## **MARY BOWMAN FELLOWSHIP INFORMATION (rev 2011)**

The Mary Bowman Fellowship is an endowed fellowship granted to a graduate student or upper division student by the Department of Kinesiology at San José State University. Students may be continuing students or new applicants, and must be full time students for the academic year in which the endowment is awarded.

Upon acceptance of the fellowship the student will serve the department by engaging in a service-oriented or volunteer project designed to support the department or the local community. The project may be serving as a volunteer in a community organization such as a recreation department, school or recognized service organization, or assisting professors with research activities, or as a peer advisor.

The fellowship is for \$500. It is provided to a student for one year. A previous year recipient may be a candidate for a second award. The fellowship will be advertised on an annual basis with the announcement made and the scholarship given in the fall.

Application for the fellowship is now open and selection is based on the best qualified. The application is to include: (1) letter of application, (2) one letter of recommendation, (3) completion of the application form, and (4) a statement of the service-oriented or volunteer project.

Determination of the fellowship award will include consideration of the following expectations:

- Cumulative grade point average (GPA) minimum 3.50 (last 60

units)

- Activity/service involvement and willingness to contribute time and effort to a worthwhile event or situation
- Demonstrated physical activity involvement and experience (includes commitment to fitness, sport participation, or other physical activity related areas)
- Evidence of character, professional/athletic experience, and academic potential as related to:

1. Leadership
2. Discipline to follow through on responsibilities
3. Dependability
4. Professional commitment

The recipient will be determined by the departmental Coordinator Council.
