

**SJSU Lucas Graduate School of Business

Special Session Open University Information**

In order to take classes through Open University, you must have a U.S. bachelor's degree or equivalent from an accredited college or university. **You may not take graduate level classes at SJSU through Open University if you have previously been denied admission to a graduate program at SJSU.**

Registration Instructions:

1. Complete the registration form. Please be sure to place a check mark next to each class you wish to take. If you are completing the entire certificate, place a check mark by all five classes where indicated.
2. Please scan or take a picture of the form and email it to catherine.dougherty@sjsu.edu at least one week prior to the beginning of the first class you wish to take.
3. Forms will be screened by the Lucas Graduate School of Business and forwarded to the Registrar's Office.
4. You will be notified by email when you are officially registered in the course and given your SJSU ID number, as well as the due date for your fees.
5. Pay your fees. Fees are \$465 per unit. See below for payment methods.
6. If you have any questions, please contact the Program Director.

Methods of Payment

All payments are handled by the Bursar's Office in the Student Services Center (www.sjsu.edu/bursar). Payments must be submitted by the due date. Submitting this form means you will be enrolled in the class (if eligible) and there is no automatic drop for non-payment of fees. Therefore, once you submit this form, you are obligated to pay the fees.

Do not submit payment until after you are notified that you have been officially enrolled in the class. In order to pay your fees, please visit the following website to review your payment options:
